An External Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) of our college for the period 2017 – 2022 was conducted by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell to evaluate the performance of the departments, suggest ways and means to improve the quality of teaching, learning and research, assess the co-curricular and extra-curricular activities as well as look into the administrative procedures and mechanisms internalized by the institution.
