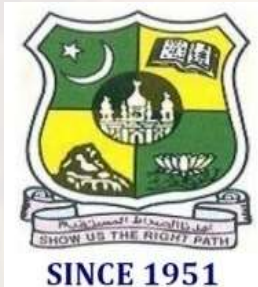

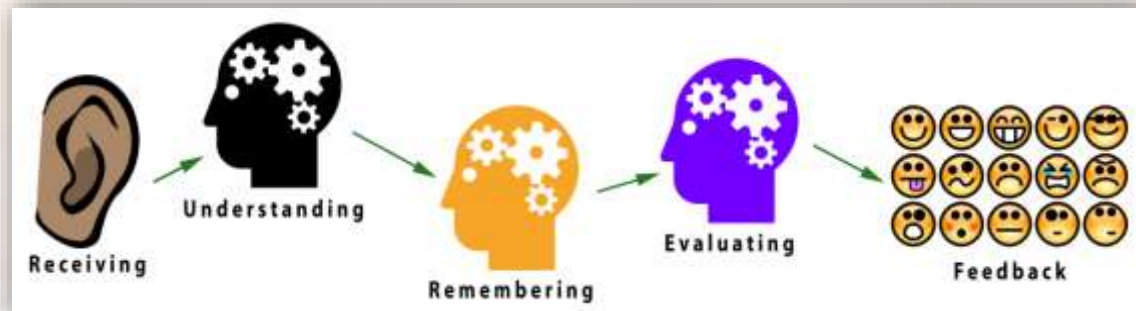

Barriers to Effective Listening

1. Physical and Environmental Barriers
2. Emotional and Psychological Barriers
3. Cultural Barriers
4. Language Barriers
5. Making Assumptions
6. Too Much Information
7. Tone of Voice

Tips for Active Listening

- **Be attentive**
- **Make eye contact**
- **Observe body language**
- **Show your interest**
- **Be Patient**
- **Avoid interruption**
- **Ask Questions at pauses**
