Scientific classification:

Kingdom : Plantae.

Binomial name: *Anachis hypogaea*.

The groundnut is also known as peanut. It is a legume crop grown mainly for its edible seeds. It is classified as both a grain legume and due to its high oil content, an oil crop.

The cashew tree is a tropical evergreen tree that produces the cashew seed and the cashew apple accessory fruit. The tree can grow as tall as 14 metres (46 feet), but the dwarf cultivations, growing up to 6m (20 ft), with earlier maturity and greater yields. The cashew seed is commonly considered a snack nut eaten on its own, used in recipes, or processed into cashew chest or cashew butter. Like the tree, the nut is often simply called a cashew.

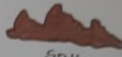
