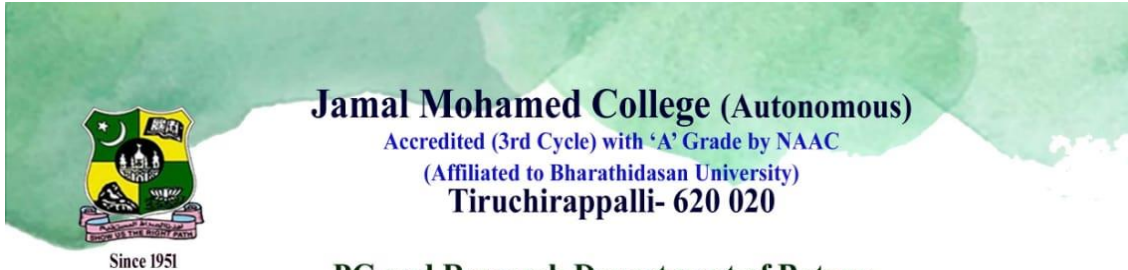

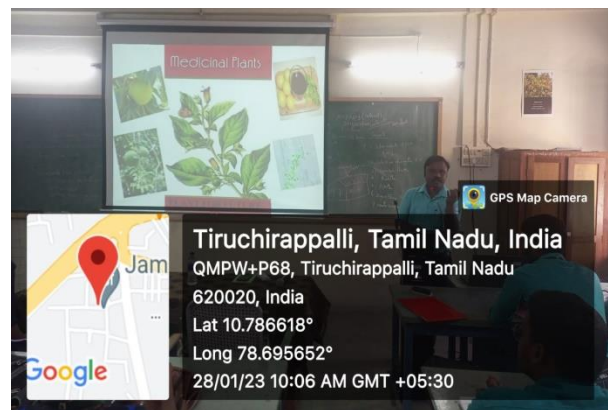

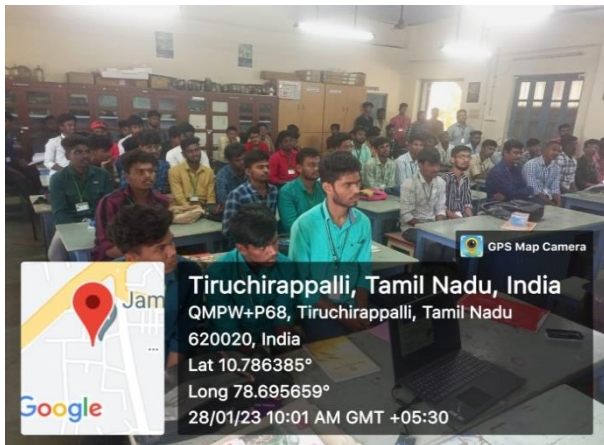

Report

The Department of Botany, Jamal Mohamed College (Autonomous), Trichy – 620 020 organized a One day Hands on Training program on “**Herbal Processing Practices for Entrepreneurship**” under the DBT STAR College scheme on 28/01/2023. The resource person **Dr. M. ARUMUGAM**, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Botany, JJ College of Arts and Science, Pudukkottai, trained our students regarding the preparation of herbal products such as Herbal Hair Oil, Herbal Hair Dye, Herbal Face Wash and Herbal Hand Sanitizer and Herbal Soap from the raw powder materials (Root, Leaves, Petals, Flower bud and Seed) like *Indigofera tinctoria*, *Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*, *Cassia auriculata*, *Lawsonia inermis*, *Nigella sativa*, *Trigonella foenum*, *Rose petals*, *Acalypha indica*, *Senna auriculata*, *Ocimum tenuiflorum*, *Azadiracta indica*, *Eclipta prostrata*, *Chrysopogan zizanioides*, *Termnalia chebula*, *Coffea arabica*, *Phyllanthus emblica* and also exhibit the production of value added products from the herbal raw materials.





Out Comes:

Students understand the value, advantages and ecofriendly nature of herbal products and also eagerly learned the different skills adopted in herbal products preparation along with the production of value added outcomes. This programme is highly motivated to become an entrepreneur in the field of herbal products particularly herbal soap, hair oil, hair dye, face wash and herbal hand sanitizer, around 30 UG students were benefitted.
