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PLAGIARISM POLICY

As per the UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (PROMOTION OF ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND PREVENTION OF PLAGIARISM IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS) REGULATIONS, 2018 and Bharathidasan University Ph.D regulations following guidelines must be adhered to establish institutional mechanism to facilitate responsible conduct of research, promotion of academic integrity and deterrence from plagiarism.

Guidelines for submitting soft copy of the thesis for plagiarism checking with anti-plagiarism software for the Research Scholars and Research Supervisor are:

1. Soft copy of the thesis/dissertation (Email copy) covering all the chapters has to be submitted in a single MS-word or searchable PDF file excluding preliminary pages: declaration, acknowledgement, abstract, list of charts and abbreviations, table of contents etc. and succeeding pages: glossary/ index/ questionnaire, references etc.
2. At present, the library facilitates access to anti-plagiarism software TURNITIN- iTHENTICATE to the Research Scholars and Research Supervisors. The time taken to check plagiarism to detect similarity index may vary from 1 hour to 24 hours. Hence plagiarism must be Checked in advance at least 15 days before submission.
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 1. All quoted work reproduced with all necessary permission and/or attribution.
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 5. Small similarity less than 10%
 6. Mathematical Formula
 7. Name of Institutions, Departments etc





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 - A. Level 0: Similarities up to 10% - minor similarities, no penalty.
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 - C. Level 2: Similarities above 40% to 60% - such student shall be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication and shall be debarred from submitting a revised script for a period of one year.
 - D. Level 3: Similarities above 60% - shall be asked to withdraw manuscript submitted for publication and such student's registration for the program shall be cancelled.
12. The decision of the Ethics Committee will decide the final recommendation to the Principal and Management.




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
