Bassanio - Antonio's close friend; suitor to Portia; later the husband of Portia





Gratiano - friend of Antonio and Bassanio; in love with Nerissa; later the husband of Neariss Lorenzo - friend of Antonio and Bassanio; in love with Jessica; later the husband of Jessica





Portia - a rich heiress; later the wife of Bassanio NERRRISA - - Portia's waiting maid - in love with Gratiano; later the wife of Gratiano; disguises herself as Portia's clerk






Balthazar - Portia's servant
