OUTLINE OF THE TALK:

Heart Disease is a leading cause of death worldwide, and affects not only the heart but also other major parts of the body. Early detection prevents complication such as heart failure, stroke, kidney disease and artery disease. Everyday 15 Singaporeans die from heart disease and it is the leading cause of death next to Cancer. About 32% of all deaths recorded in Singapore are due to cardiovascular disease.

Coronary artery disease is the narrowing or blockage of the artery or arteries supplying blood to the heart muscle. This narrowing is caused by plaques, which are cholesterol deposits on the vessel wall, resulting in abnormal and gradual thickening of the lining of the heart arteries (a condition known as atherosclerosis). The narrowing usually develops slowly over many years and it could be prevented if early action is taken.

There are several conditions called as 'risk factors', which is responsible for the narrowing and blockage of the coronary arteries. Once these risk factors are identified and addressed properly the risk of a heart attack drops dramatically. This Talk will cover the signs, symptoms and the latest management strategies for Heart Diseases.
