Evaluation

Ratio of CIA and ESE:

- For all theory courses (100 Marks) the ratio is 25:75
- All practical courses (100 Marks) ratio is 20 : 80
- For a single paper divided into two papers (Theory-50 Marks +Practical-50 Marks) the ratio is 20: 80, the corresponding course credits for theory should be more than or equal to the practical.
- If a single paper is divided into two papers, the Examinations should be conducted in the same semester.
- Theory and Practicals of PG Diploma, COP and other Certificate Programmes are in the ratio 25:75.
