

Swachh Bharat Summer Internship Course

(The course is a joint initiative of the **Ministry of Human Resource Development and the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Government of India**)

Duration: 100 Hours (between 1st May and 31st July 2018)

Eligible Applicants: Students studying second and third years of UG and second year PG during 2018-19.

Benefits: Ministry of Human Resource Development has directed to treat the course equivalent to 2 credits and awards for select 3 students at national level. Students can avail exemption from undergoing one Non-Major Elective after completing the internship.

Internship Course Details: Students have to spend 100 hours in a village of their own choice for doing the following activities.

- Conducting awareness campaign relating to evils of open defecation using ICT and other media
- Creating amenities to collect, segregate and dispose solid waste
- Creating low cost amenities to stop open defecation and improve sanitation

Registration Process: Students of team size 1 to 10 can enrol through sbsimygov.in on or before 15th July 2018.

Date for Completion of the Internship: 1 May 2018 to 31 July 2018 and submit online report within 15 days after completion. Students will get certificate once Nodal Officer of the college approves the completion.
