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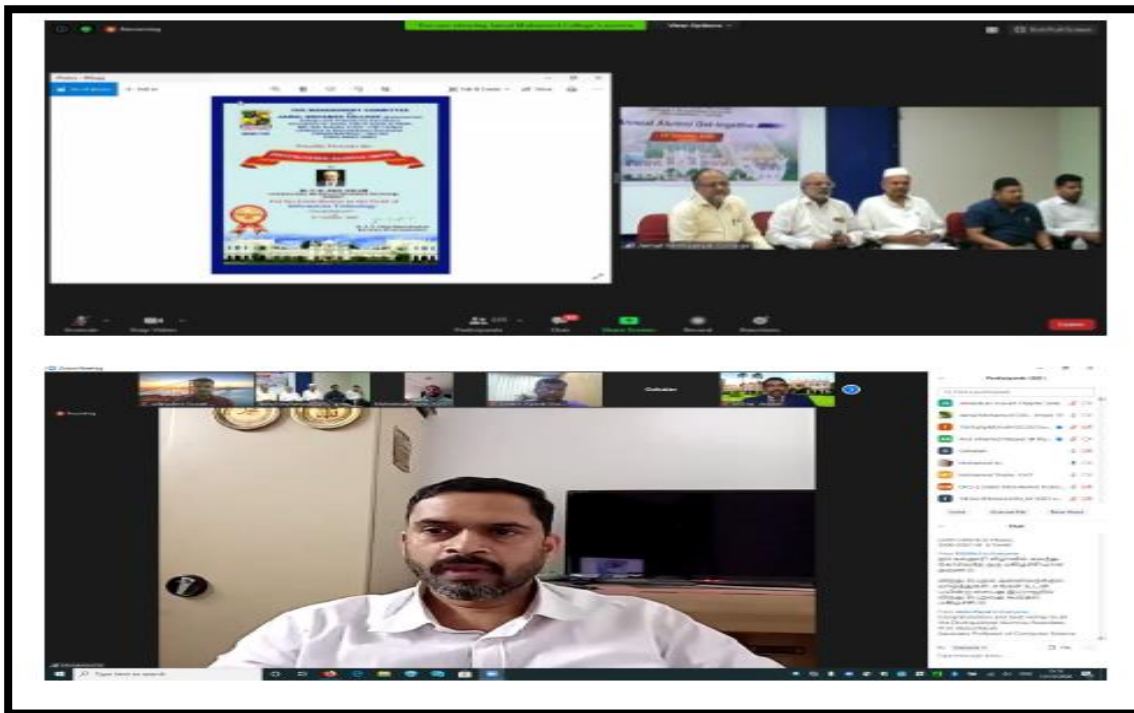
12,030 towards the scholarship, of which Rs.46,79,038 was the contribution by the alumni. A total of 682 students were benefitted through this scholarship.
