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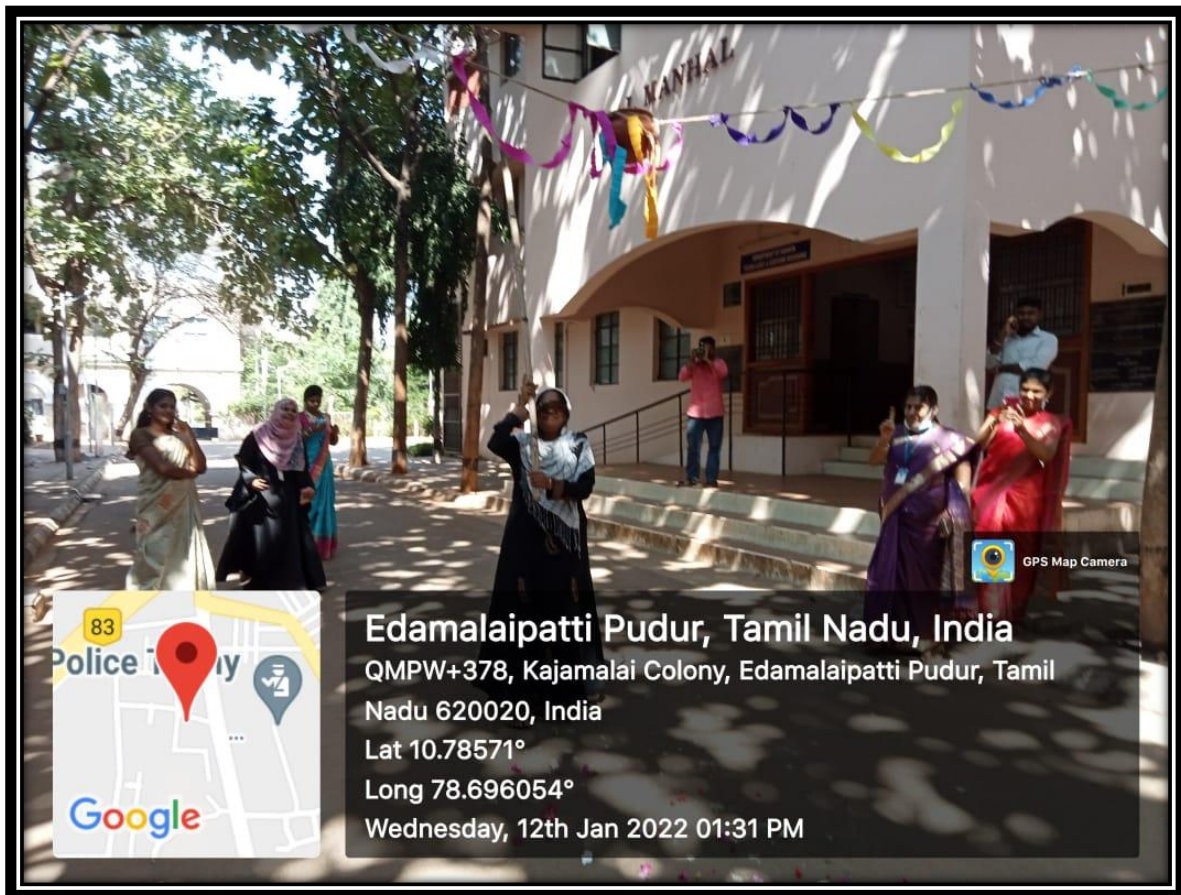

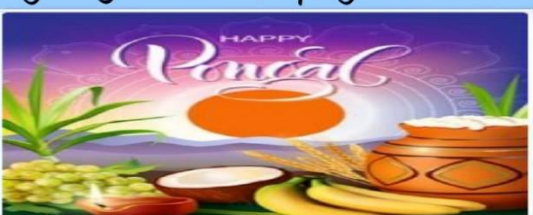

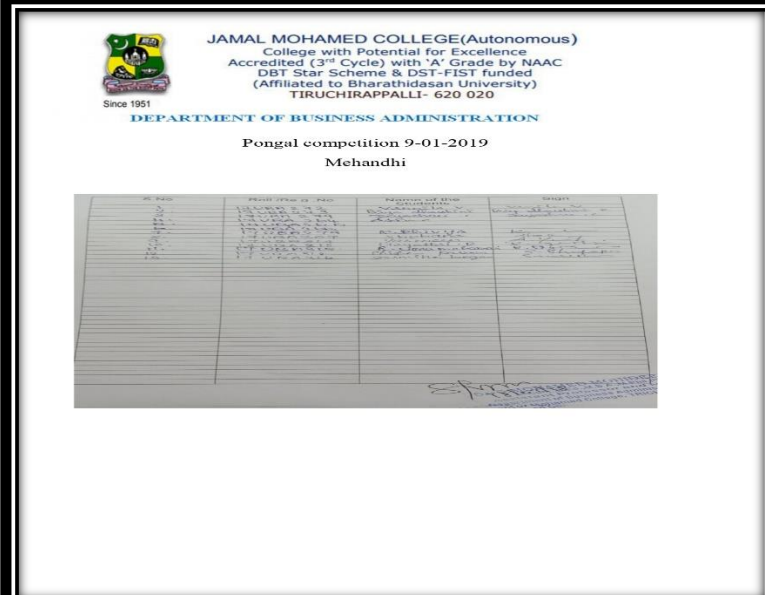

SPEECH COMPETITION RULES

Round 1 In the 1st round, each contestant will present a five (5)-minute prepared speech. After that the judges will ask them questions. The judges will select the top 15 contestants from Round 1 of the competition on the base of the scores.

Round 2 (Round 2 of the competition will be conducted. The top 15 contestants selected from the previous day will be required to make a 5- minute impromptu speech based on a topic to be given to each participant by lot before the audience. From Round 2, the top 5 contestants will be chosen to participate in the final Round.

Voice: While delivering the speech, the voice should be flexible, easy to move from one pitch to another. The voice should be clear, so that the words can be easily understood.

Manner of Delivery: This will indirectly reveal the true state of the speaker. The speaker should speak with confidence and must show interest in his/her audience. Language (20%) Appropriateness refers to the choice of words that is related to the purpose of the speech.

The language should give a clear picture of the thoughts being expressed. Correctness of the language refers to the proper usage of the grammar and correct pronunciation of the words.

Final Round (Afternoon) The top 5 contestants will be asked to deliver an impromptu speech no more than 5 minutes based on a topic to be given by the judges on the spot. The selection of top three contestants will be based on the average score obtained from the final round of the competition.
