Best Practice - I

Moral & Deeniyath Education

Objectives:

To instill ethical values and foster social responsibility

To enhance character development

To help pupils become well-rounded individuals and to develop them to perfection

To foster the student's uniqueness through helpful, practical, and the technique and purposeful substance of moral instruction.

To use natural resources wisely and to safeguard, conserve, and preserve the natural and cultural environment

To give pupils the ability to discriminate between right and wrong, good and bad, and to develop the mental acuity and disposition necessary to act morally upright and morally upright.

The Context:

Education without morals is perilous. Moral & Ethics have always been the prime aim of education at Jamal Mohamed College. The mission of the college is to offer quality education, inculcating and nurturing ethical, spiritual, moral and human values. Hence, it was in the thought of the members of the College Management Committee to introduce moral education to all the students of the college.

The pressures of modern-day society, such as peer influence, social media, and the competitive nature of academics and careers, often lead to ethical dilemmas and a lack of clarity regarding right and wrong. Moral education helps students navigate these complexities by teaching them core values like integrity, respect, responsibility, fairness, and compassion.



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The Practice:

Moral instruction is a compulsory course open to all UG and PG students of the college. For the effective dissemination of good values and ethics, the students are clustered into various groups according to their year of study. For all men students the moral instruction classes are held on every Thursday after the end of their regular class hours. For women students the classes are offered on every Friday after the regular classes. All students, both men and women are instructed well in advance about the purpose of the course and the venue of their class.

The Centre for Human Excellence has designed a detailed curriculum for Moral Education with 12 lessons (level 1) for first year and thus for second year (Level 2) and for third year (level3) were made available with various select topics. Textbooks for all the three levels of study were carefully scrutinized and they have been passes in the college general Academic Council. These moral instruction books are distributed to all students for reference.

Every week, students who are clustered into various groups are taught by different moral instructor to avoid the boredom of the same style of instruction. Attendance is compulsory for all students and absentees will be intimated to the parents.

Evidence of Success:

At the end of the required number of moral instruction hours (12 Class), students have to appear for a competitive examination. The first three rank holders in each paper are given cash prizes on the day of Meeladunnabi function. The department from which the first rank holder hails would be awarded the Hajee. M.N.P. Rolling Cup. The certificates are issued to those students obtaining 60 marks and above in the examination.

Feedback from our institution's students and graduates indicates that moral education helped them discover the correct course in life. It helped them cultivate and consider their values and their ability to make moral decisions. They also demonstrated how moral education foster



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responsible attitudes toward others by fostering an understanding and appreciation of the worth of every individual in a multicultural community. In order to give students more in-depth, pleasurable, and engaging experiences, it is also noted that Moral Education experiences and results promoted connections with other curriculum areas. These encounters greatly aided in the growth of the abilities of effective contributors, self-assured people, responsible citizens, and successful learners.

Problems encountered and resources required:

The biggest issue is student absenteeism; as moral education go outside the parameters of the standard curriculum and are not recorded on grade sheets, students often exhibit a lack of interest in these courses. In addition to the standard teaching activities, the institution must set aside extra instructional hours for teaching and evaluation.
