## **REPORT ON THE WORKSHOP**

### **Outcomes of the Workshop:**

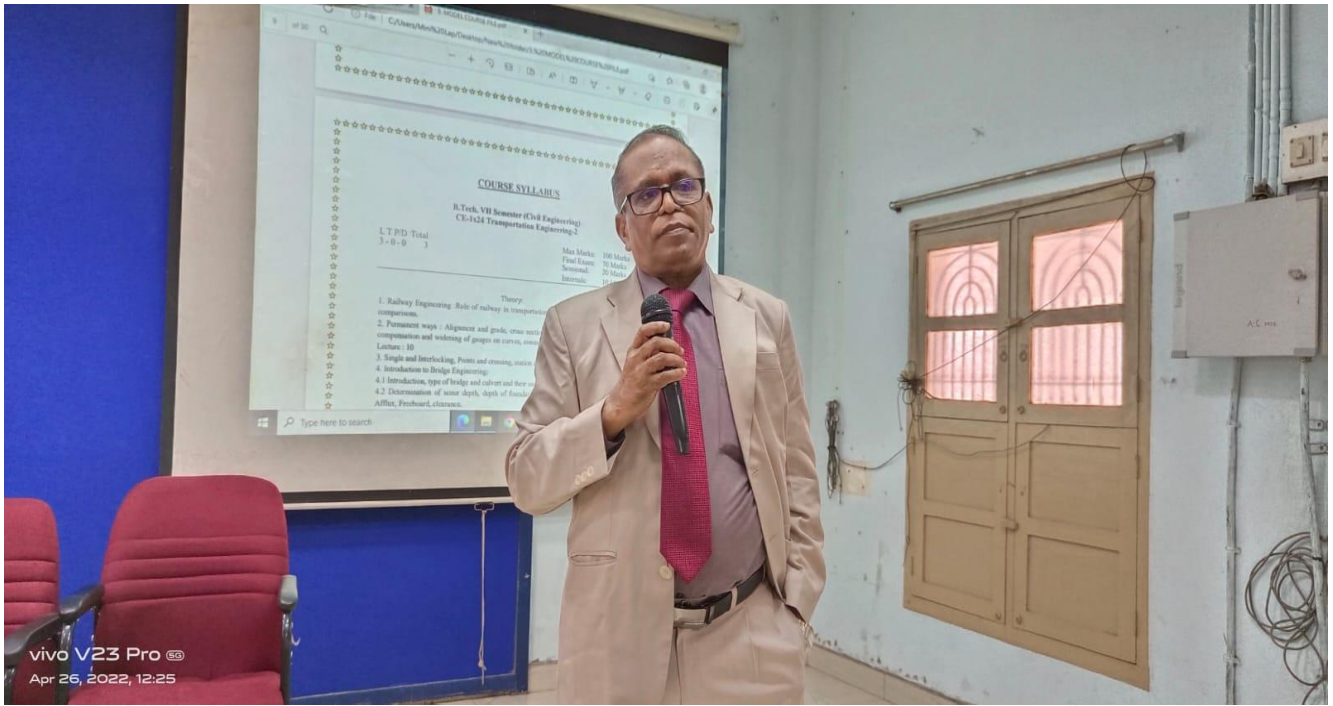
1. The workshop paved way for the faculty members to understand the salient features of Outcome Based Education (OBE).
