The Awareness Programme on First Aid of Zoology Association (SF-Women) were organized on Tuesday, 12th October 2022. The awareness programme started with the address of Mr. Arul kumar, District In-charge, 108 Ambulance Service, Tiruchirappalli, who spoke on the leads to “**EMRI GREEN HEALTH SERVICE PERFORMANCE**”. Dr. I. Joseph Antony Jerald (Head, Dept of Zoology) welcomed the gathering and introduced the guest speakers. Dr. K. Abdus Samad, Assistant Secretary gave the presidential address. He stressed the importance of First aid Awareness programme. Dr. Mohamed Shamsudin (MID), mentioned very clearly the various attributes of the Zoology women section and Nal Ullangal Trust. Mr. P. Saravanan, Emergency Medical Technician, 108 Ambulance Services, Tiruchirappalli, demonstrated to our students, the need and use of the equipments kept in the 108 ambulance. The speakers explained how to stop bleeding, managing the crowd, trying to prevent unconsciousness, reassuring the victim that things would be fine, informing the family and calling the ambulance. This was aptly followed by the explanation of the Chain of Survival. While stating that Advanced Life Support is the medical care with injections and other advanced equipment. So we thought we could do our part in making our students aware through this program. It was a very informative day for the students, getting to know the requirements of saving a person at crucial times. Nearly 100 students participated in the Awareness Programme. Mrs. H. F. Seyed Mafiya Haniff, Vice President of the Zoology Association (SF-W) proposed a Vote of Thanks. The session was well attended by our staff Dr. P. Dhanalakshmi of our department and Dr. A.
