## National Service Scheme Special Camp Report

On the first day of the camp, on Thursday 23.12.2021, 250 students and National Service Scheme Programme Officers Dr. S. Mohamed Yusuff Ansari, Dr. B. Mohamed Rafeeq, Dr. S. Gopi, Dr. S. 


At 2.30 pm NSS volunteers cleaned the area where the rainwater harvesting tank is located in the Panchayat Union Primary School in Burma Colony.


