

Five-day National Workshop on Art of Research Article writings and Publications (Online Mode) from 27th to 31st January. 2022

Summary of Day 1

Inaugural session:

The Workshop started on 27th January 2022 at 10:00 am with prayer by Dr. S. Dawood Ali, Associate Professor, Jamal Institute of Management. Dr. U. Syed Aktharsha, Director i/c and Convener of workshop Jamal Institute of Management, delivered the welcome address. The Presidential Address was delivered by Dr. S. Ismail Mohideen, Principal Jamal Mohamed College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli. He shared that the focus of this Workshop is on how to inculcate the habit of article writing and publications. The session of day four was handled by Dr.G.S.David Sam Jayakumar, Associate Professor and Member In charge of Department, Jamal Institute of Management and Dr. Pranam Dhar with very informative lectures. The felicitator provides back ground knowledge, major philosophical thought that added newer theoretical orientation, emergence, importance of objectives in research, Importance of references, citation and bibliography in detail.
