- > disciplinary action against the defaulters

Definitions

- The IT infrastructure refers to all the computer laboratory facilities, internet connectivity through LAN/ Wi-Fi platforms, infrastructure for preparing ICT enabled teaching and learning modules, digital library facility, e-learning resources, Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) set-up, 24 x 7 campus surveillance system using CCTV cameras, biometric attendance monitoring system etc.
- Administrative activities refer to Financial Management, Admission Process, Payment of Fees, Attendance Maintenance for students and by biometric means for the staff, Examination Process etc.
- Academic activities refer to the usage of the computer laboratory facilities, internet browsing for academic content, arranging of online classes, webinars, conferences, preparation and uploading of digital content, accessing e-resources in the library etc.
- ➤ Beneficiaries refer to faculty, students, pre-doctoral and doctoral scholars, non-teaching staff, vendors and visitors

Usage of IT Facilities

It will be the endeavor of the System Administrator to facilitate use of the IT facilities by all the beneficiaries without any discrimination

- All the teaching faculty will be given login credentials by the ERP Administrator for access to the college's ERP platform for recording of attendances, uploading of teaching content, teaching plan, intimation of assignments and their evaluation
- > The students, upon admission into the college will be given login credentials to access the college's ERP platform to know of their attendance details, assignments, dates of submission, internal marks etc.
- ➤ All the teaching faculty, students and non-teaching staff members can register with the college System Administrator to obtain user credentials for Wi-Fi connectivity.
- ➤ All the teaching faculty, postgraduates and research scholars can register with the librarian to obtain login credentials to access the databases such as NLIST-INFLIBNET, PROQUEST, DELNET subscribed by the library.
- > The faculty may be provided with remote login facilities upon request.
- > The research scholars desirous of remote login may apply through their research supervisors for the same.

Misuse and Disciplinary Actions

The beneficiaries should abide by the conditions stipulated for using IT facilities

- All the facilities should be used purely for academic or administrative purposes only
- > The beneficiaries should not play/download videos/games/cinematic content nor access erotic websites
- > The faculty/scholars accessing databases subscribed by the library should do so only for advancing of their research and not for pecuniary benefits.
- > The beneficiaries found indulging in misuse may face disciplinary action which may include payment of fine, suspension of accounts or complete withdrawal of the access.
